 Jewish people around the world
- Jewish Values: Complete the lessons in the "Mensch Series: How to be a good person"
- Jewish Culture: Jewish Art, Jewish Sports Legends, Jewish America, Jewish New York
- Jewish Home: Shabbat, Mezuzzah, Judaica in the home
- Jewish Living: Bar/Bat Mitzvah, Wedding, Funerals
- Exposure to Jewish Stories: Study the themes in the Torah and learn some of the most important stories: Adam/Eve, Noah's Ark, Abraham and Sarah, Exodus, Golden Calf, 10 Commandments, Moses and Miriam
