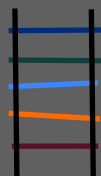


JACOB'S LADDER

THE PRAYERS WE KNOW

Every week during "community meeting time" we learn and experience Jewish prayer. Prayer intensives begin in 5th grade where students become proficient in approximately 25 prayers from the Shabbat prayer service

THE VALUES WE PRACTICE

The Ethics curriculum occurs during the 6th/7th grade B'nai Mitzvah class and is taught by the rabbis. Students study the source text of Jewish Ethics, Pirkey Avot, and discuss how these values influence the way we live in a modern world.

THE LANGUAGE WE LEARN

Hebrew learning at Tamid happens in the classroom and at home with the online learning center. Tamid has six levels of Hebrew learning from letters, to prayer, to modern Hebrew.
