The enlarged **Y** *sin* at the end of **שְׁמָעֵ** *Sh'ma* (Hear) and the enlarged **T** *dalet* at the end of **אֶחָד** (one) combine to spell **תָּיִד** *eid* (witness). We recite the *Sh'ma* to bear witness to the Oneness of God.
