Dear Tamid,

We are pleased to announce that membership and re-enrollment for next year is now open. **We began a practice in our first year to offer current members the option of re-enrollment for next year at this year's fees.** This provides returning members a small discount and gives our congregation a better sense of how to build our budget and our faculty model for next year.

Re-enrollment and membership renewal for current families will be through June 30, 2021. Fees and tuition will increase on July 1, 2021.

Fees and Tuition 2021-22 (5782)

Last year, in recognition of a worldwide pandemic, we did not raise our fees or tution. This year, our Va'ad (Board of Directors) approved increases of 2-3% to cover increased costs of our robust virtual programs, safety practices, and increased scholarships and financial aid.

Scholarships and Financial Aid

For families with hardships, Tamid has grown our financial aid offerings. We want everyone who desires to be part of the Tamid family to have their honored place. Please contact Christina Broussard directly if you require assistance.

Tzedakah Donations - please donate if you are able

Membership and tuition cover only 65% of our annual budget. In other words, the membership and tuition amount that each family pays is only 65% of what it actually costs Tamid -- on average -- to serve and to educate each student and family. If you are financially able, please donate an additional amount to help us raise \$300,000. We welcome individuals, family foundations, and corporate matching. Thank you!

FAQ: My Child had their Bar/Bat mitzvah. What now?

While it's true that some people see bar/bat mitzvah as the finish line, for us, it's only the starting point! Not only are Tamid Teen programs incredible for our youth, we are also a community of adults and families. There are times when you need a rabbi and a Jewish community to support you and the people you love. That's what we do. And we accomplish this by asking for your commitment to lifelong membership so that the seeds we plant may blossom forever.

Payment Methods

We accept American Express, Visa, and Mastercard. We also accept pay by check in-full or over-time. Important Information

- 1. Students in the B'nai Mitzvah (7th grade) and Pre-Mitzvah (6th grade) classes must be enrolled at the family membership level (two-parent or single-parent family level).
- 2. Please consider adding additional family members (ie. grandparents, aunts, uncles, siblings, etc., as "auxiliary members") to your family membership for \$180 each. We value intergenerational family activity and want to support the "whole family."
- 3. Children who have completed the 2-year B'nai Mitzvah program and have their ceremony in the following year do not need to re-enroll in Hebrew School. In this situation, your family only needs to maintain your family membership.
- 4. We invite individuals and couples that join our online programs (Book Club, L'chayim Shabbat, Holiday gatherings, Talkabout, etc.) to become official members so that we may continue to serve your Jewish life needs.
- 5. Next year, Hebrew School grades K-7 will be offered both in-person (Wednesdays) and virtually online (Thursdays). Mitzvah Corps for grades 8-12 will meet Wednesday in-person. Click here for the 2021-22 Hebrew School schedule.
